

# HAND READING : The meanings of our 5 fingers

Palm reading is a practice that involves interpreting the lines, shapes, form, texture and other features of person's hands to gain insight into their health, character, personality traits, relationships, past and potential future events. As the hands are a reflection of an individual's inner self, they can reveal information about their past, present, and future.

Chinese palmistry, has a long history that dates back to ancient times, including the imperial period of China. In Chinese culture, the practice of palm reading was considered an important tool for understanding a person's character, destiny, and potential. It is one of the fascinating subjects of Chue Style lineage that we can still study today, alongside with Body reading and Face reading, thanks to Grand master Chan Kun Wah.

Each of our fingers has a meaning and is linked to our ancestors, our siblings, spouses, children and ourselves. They also reflect different stages of life, among many other things:

- 1. finger: The thumb relates to our parents and our childhood
- 2. finger: Index finger relates to our siblings and our school age period
- 3. finger: Middle finger relates to ourselves and our working period
- 4. finger: Ring finger relates to our spouse and our period of creating family
- 5. finger: Little finger relates to our children and our later life

Different fingers, depending on their appearance, health, shape, curve, skin texture and quality, can tell us about our relations with different family members.

For example, when a thumb finger looks very nice, healthy and strong, our parents are loving and helpful. If the ring finger is very good looking, then the partner can help us in life. It also shows how close we are with certain family members. When index finger is curved in, towards middle finger, it means our siblings are close to us and they always rely on us. It may also mean that they are dependent on us. If, for example, the ring finger is curved out (away from middle finger), it means our partner likes to go out and is not relying on us, but is very independent.

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At different age, we can also look at certain finger to see how that life period is like.

For male, their left hand represents the time when they are young and their right hand represents the time after they get married, or create their own family.

For a female, it is the opposite - their right hand is when they are young and their left hand is the time when they get married & create a family.

The relation between the fingers and the palm is also important. The fingers are called the dragon (they are most active, yang) and the palm is called the tiger (yin part of the hand). Most people have fingers shorter than their palm and some have their fingers longer than their palm. When fingers are longer than the palm, it means the dragon is controlling the tiger; these people are very positive, very clever and can become great leaders.

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### THE FORM TELLS YOU ABOUT THE ENERGY Composed by Senior Master Jacqueline Miettinen (FS/IC/DS/CH/GD-YHH)

As we know, ENERGY FOLLOWS THE FORM.

In the past a Feng Shui Master would travel from mountain to mountain to find suitable places to build a new Capital city, to build new palaces, to build tombs. They would then look at the mountains and waters to tell them something about the energy.

Nowadays, it is still possible to deduct something when a form has something very special:

The following examples all located in Catalunya, Spain.

1 - The first and most impressive is the mountain of Monserrat, located in the NW of Barcelona.

Suddenly this impressive and powerful Por Kwan shows when approaching the town from almost all directions, like guard showing the teeth.

One immediately understands that this mountain is guarding the Capital of Catalunya.

It is also understood that the people living inside might not be very accessible and that they might be ruthless when it comes to business.

The location in the North West, the leader position, it is giving the mountain even more strength. Spiritual power as well, as the famous 11<sup>th</sup> Century Monserrat monastery is where all the people of Barcelona and the famous football teams also go to pray.



2 - The next mountain suddenly appears in a flat plain:

This is when the river and mountain are close by: the mountain shapes are called Mou Kuk and Goy Moon, both can store energy.

Here the stored energy is referring to the rice that grows in the fields at the bottom of the mountain. There are also plenty of orchards. If you plant here, you are sure to get something to eat.



3 - The last and smaller formation looks like an animal diving out of the water: This is actually a famous divers' destination with a lot of rare fish species.



This is to tell you that everything in nature tells us something about the energy. If we can read it, we will be able to combine with it.

From the bigger scale of a town to the smaller scale of a house.

### FORM FENG SHUI : MONTREUX (Switzerland) A town of music and artists. Composed by Master Laurent Paillard (ICD)



When we talk about Feng Shui, we take into account two aspects of the environment.

The first has to do with the shape of our surroundings, that which we can see in the distance, the shape of the mountains, the shape of a building, the position in space of a place and what it can bring in terms of energy to the people who live there and what they will do with it over time.

The second aspect will be to take measurements with the compass to get an orientation that will give us additional information on the precise orientation of the site so that we can understand whether the shape and orientation are in harmony.

I'd like to briefly show you a Swiss town, Montreux, which is linked to music, comedy and an international meeting place for the spoken word, the mouth and the voice.



When we look at the photo taken from the "Place du Marché", a convivial place for discussions, we can see that we have 2 arms on either side of the image, holding back the energy so that Montreux can keep its Qi.

In Feng Shui we associate the arms with 2 animals:



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For the left side the dragon, the masculine side, strength, work, finances, if this one is strong, it will give strength to men.



For the right side, we'll use the tiger as an animal, in relation to feminine energy, relaxation, rest and creation. If it's strong, the woman will be well supported.

We also want to have a tortoise on the back to give the city a foundation, protection over time, stability, support, health and durability.

This is the case for this city, which lies at the foot of several mountains.

One of these is in the shape of a tooth, in connection with the trigram it is looking at.

On the front we have the phoenix, which we want to be clear and open so that we can see into the distant future and take the right long-term decisions. Imagine a bird that needs space to fly away, in this case we have plenty of room to do so as we are facing the lake.

The last critera we'll take into account is the orientation taken with the compass. In this case we're facing West, which is linked to the trigram of the mouth,  $\equiv$  Doey. The 2 open yin lines at the top, represent the eyes of a person and the 2 continuous yang lines at the bottom the 2 lips of a mouth.

This trigram represents the third girl, the one who is sent to the ball to find a suitor and who will charm men with her melodious voice, she is also called the lake and the marsh.

Each trigram represents many aspects, but in this case we'll stick to the subject.

It represents the mouth and is linked to openness, sound, voice, music and singing.

If we look at the history of Montreux, we know that in 1967 the Jazz Festival was created and in 1989 the Montreux Festival Comedy, 2 festive events where the voice was the first instrument used to promote these 2 festivals.





The trigram Doey  $\cong$  has metal as its element, so we'll also be linked to the music produced by a saxophone, piano or any musical instrument.

The people of this place will have followed the form, used the chi to make events with an international scope.

The final aspect to consider is water, an element that can bring wealth, and here too we have a link between the theory and reality of the chi form. Water is an essential element in the life of this city.



The dragon side, which is very powerful, has favoured the men who create the festivals, and has attracted famous artists such as Freddy Mercury, but the tiger side, with its roundness and softness, has brought the femininity needed for creation and open-mindedness, and Shania Twain lives there.

Many artists have performed and will continue to perform on the various stages.

The orientation will have provided all the parameters to create, feast, speak and charm.

# CHUE STYLE BUSINESS CONSULTATION: What to focus on?

Most of Feng Shui practitioners worldwide don't concentrate on the outside surroundings when doing a consultation. Their focus is solely on the internal part of property.

For Chue Style consultants, the outside form of a property is of prime importance. This applies for any type of consultation, residential or business.

If we don't consider the form of property, how can we understand the energy of the property? There is no way of knowing whether the energy is good or bad, without looking at external form first.

The form school is very important, however not divided from compass school. For a quality feng shui service, both need to be used correctly. This is what differentiates our genuine Chue Style Feng Shui from other schools in the market.

When doing a business consultation, we bring our attention to:

- We need to understand the FORM first
- Then we observe where the Chi is coming from the road, or street
- The gate of the property represents its own energy getting in and we need to know in which of the 12 palaces that is. This is the main focus of any business consultation; **the door**.
- From the gate, we want to grasp strong chi, such as Chang Sang 長生, Koon Tai 冠带, Lum Kun 臨官, or Dai Wong 帝旺
- It's important to avoid the dead, sick, or hopeless chi at the door, such as Sai 死, Bang 病, Chua 絶
- Even when we look at the Ba Chop method, we need to know where the door is and we'd like it to be on strong stars, such as 'Vitality', or 'Tin Yi - healthy & wealthy' to bring in the positive and abundant energy for the business.

The main difference between a business and residential house consultation is that for a business the door is more important then the site. For a residential house, the site is most important. The site represents health and human, whereas the door represents money and the future. For a business, the customers always come in through the door, so they depend on it. In a business consultation we need to be mindful whether the door can combine with the road or not. That means if the outside Chi, or the road coming into the property, connects with the Chi of the business door. A link must be made to secure the good energy flow coming in.

One of the Chue Style specialties is that we work with 64 kwa's or hexagrams of the I Ching and their inner qualities (6 kinships). These are the precise orientations that occupy 360° on our Lo Pan and we study them in depth during our certification programs and advanced courses.

A front door of a property, specially of a business, must be on active/weak kwa. If we want quick results, the kwa needs to be aligned with the current 9 fate.

An active front door will bring more customers, opportunities and money, if the kinship inside the kwa also has money energy, Choi 才. Ideally, we want 2x Choi 才 at the door, so more business can come in. Best kwa for the door is the one that is active, with the current fate and has all 3 kinships present: Chee 子, Choi 才, and Kun 官.

Career 子 is producing the money 才, and power 官 helps to control the money as well as organise the business.

On the other hand, having a business door with double Hing 兄, or double Foo 父, will not create enough money. There is no chance for the business to make it if their main door has no money 才 in the kwa.

When doing a business consultation we need to be careful about another delicate meassurement of the front door.

After we get a kwa reading of the door, the focus is on the **72 dragons**.

The 72 dragons are revealing the real Chi of the property. It depends on the quality of the 72 dragons (measured at the door) whether the business can survive or not. These qualities are called: **Cool, Pure, Failiure, Strong, Fade.** 

When the door is aligned to Pure, or Strong chi of 72 dragon, the energy getting into that property will be very good and the business can prosper.

If a door is aligned to Failure chi dragon, the business will vanish sooner or later. The Failure is also called the 'Volcano line' and it is the worst of all 5 qualities of the 72 dragons. 'Cool' and 'Fade' chi are not as bad as 'Failure' chi, which has no energy at all. If a door kwa is active/weak and is sitting on the 'Failure' chi dragon, it means the problems can start very quickly. Such property is always producing challenges and customers bring in trouble.

Another step which should not be overlooked, when doing a feng shui consultation is **how to feel the energy.** Again, we bring our attention to the

outside first. More specifically, we need to stand at front of the property by the door. Observing the property from the door, looking outside, we need to feel comfortable. This means the energy is good. If our feeling is uncomfortable, or at some places we may even feel scared, upset or overwhelmed - it is telling us that the property will create many problems if we take it. For a business consultation this is very important, because when the energy doesn't feel comfortable at the door, such property will not create a good business.

To sense the Chi, we stand at the front, looking out from the door, looking to the left & right-hand side. Then we close our eyes, take a deep breath and sense how we feel. This is the intuition or the property showing us it's energy.

To heighten these senses, we practice imperial Qi Gong, which is also something we can learn from our Chue Style Qi Gong teachers.

Another important observation comes from the surrounding properties. It means, that other properties nearby also affect the business. This applies for the next-door properties, as well as those opposite. These locations need to feel comfortable and look nice. Apart from the appearance and their energy, it is also important as to what type of products they sell. As this is the energy they attract and work with. If, for example, our business property is a coffee shop, we don't want the next door & opposite shops to be selling either pet foods, or pharmaceutical products. In first case, there is a mix of animal and human chi and the pharmacy is for the sick, which isn't favourable for the coffee shop business.

Both Form and Chi are especially important for any business consultation and there are several observations and measurements we need to make before giving advice to the client. Grand Master Chan has done thousands of business consultations around the world and has a lifetime of experience. We are so grateful that he shares so openly with us these valuable lessons!



### CHUE STYLE DICE I-CHING ON PROPERTY INVESTMENT Composed by Susanna Senior Master Lau (GD: FS/YHH/DS/IC/ICD)

Grand Master Chan invented the Chue Style Dice I-Ching prediction (隨骰卦), which he modified it from the Plum Flower method (梅花易術). Many of our students have learnt the skill and are using it for predictions. We use the method to predict many things including, but not limited to, fate, wealth, health, relationship, property transactions, travelling, lost items.



I was grateful on this occasion to assist Grand Master Chan in advising one of his long-term clients. This client was more than 7,000 km away from Grand Master Chan and would like to invest in some local properties. With keen competition among buyers, our investment decisions, which involved millions of pounds, have to be quick. We do not need to visit the property. Simply by using our authentic knowledge and skill of the 8 trigrams, we are able to identify with high accuracy which property units are worth investing. The client has been using our service to acquire a portfolio of property investment, and the return has been satisfactory.

Below is an extraction of WhatsApp messages between us on one of the property developments. It demonstrates how quickly we, as Chue practitioners are able to give our client advice. Without physically viewing the property, we already know the surrounding environment and are able to identify good Feng Shui property.

(Quoted with "" are the client's messages)

At 14:37, the client sent the property details and brochure to Grand Master Chan for review.

14:38 : "Every unit available"

14:43 : "Apparently to guarantee best views are the units facing the pool. Other units are facing community and roads"

At this point, Grand Master Chan and I were working on the prediction using the Chue Style Dice I-Ching. The readings suggested that units with pool view are not worth investing because of crashing energy (fire crashing metal, and wood crashing earth). This also means these units have sat chi or poisoned energy. Something solid is blocking the side of the pool view, it could be a building. At 14:57, we asked for the direction of the pool.

15:02 : "The pool is in the Northeast/East of the building"

15:04 : "There is a neighbour plot so we need to expect a building"

We already knew there is something blocking the pool view; we urged the client not to listen to the property agent's advice on buying 3-bedroom units facing the pool.

15:05 : "Or 2 bed" "In any of the 3 directions"

I replied five minutes later and suggested to purchase 3-bedroom unit which has scarcity value. This is Grand Master Chan's opinion, although he has not been visiting the country for many years. He understands the energy in that country, including the people and the property market.

Grand Master Chan always said, one need to understand the energy before dealing with it. This is similar to the importance of understanding the person sleeps next to you; if the couple does not understand each other then the relationship will not last long. The client agreed with Grand Master Chan after doing some research of the market with the property agency.

At 15:32, we finalised and advised the client to buy a specific 3-bedroom unit facing the community and roads. Despite the fact that all the property agencies were hard selling the pool-view units of the new development.

15:34 : "Strange it's not facing pool. I will go in the morning and see what view is from there".

Next morning, I received a video filmed by our client at the construction site. One can see far away from the 3-bedroom units we have chosen. There are low rise buildings and the major commercial centre is situated right opposite to the unit.

On the contrary, the pool view units will be overlooking another big piece of land with planning permission for a high-rise development. We do not know the shape of the building however it is obvious the view will be totally blocked and unpleasant.

The client found this amazing and unbelievable that we have the ability to see things so clearly without being there.

There is no black magic or "opening of the third eyes" which some people may refer to.

This is the strength of the Chue Style Feng Shui, and we are unique. The fundamental and skills in the various topics, including Chee Ba flying star, Ba Chop, 6-kinship I-Ching, dice I-Ching, date selection, Chinese horoscopes, body and face reading, spiritual charms, etc, can all be linked together. All the Chue Style Feng Shui knowledge is science and logical.

### FENG SHUI AND PAST RELATIONSHIPS Composed by Anne Hendrickx

A woman contacted me for a feng shui consult regarding her house. She couldn't exactly tell me why but she definitely wanted me to come. It struck me that she talked a lot about her late husband, so I thought he died recently. After questioning her she told me her husband died 15 years ago and that she now lives with her current partner of 10 years in the same house, together with his teenage daughter. Interesting to know is that her current partner had also lost his former wife.

The client informed me the relationship with her step-daughter was not very good as they had many conflicts. After I did my measurements and looked thoroughly at the house and the surroundings, keeping in mind what she told me, it was clear that there was a lot of clashing energy in the house related to generation conflicts.

They also had pictures of the deceased husband and wife in the living space. Even the urns were placed central in the living space. Also, in their bedroom there were pictures of the deceased.

It caught my attention that the backdoor was totally blocked with heavy furniture and they used a sliding window to go to the backyard instead.

Everything was telling me that it was difficult to let go of the past and live in the present.

• I advised to open up the backdoor and start using it again, as the measurements were also good.

• For the urns and pictures of the deceased I selected an energetic quiet area in a space they passed through to go upstairs. I asked them gently to move everything to the selected area and also to remove the pictures out of their bedroom and replace it with a picture of something they both would love to do in the future.

• In the open living space and centre of the house I advised a colour to neutralise the clashing energy.

It took my client some time but after she applied my advice and her friends came to visit, they said: what have you done? It feels so much different in here and lighter. Also, she told me enthusiastically about the new plans they were making. Something shifted in a positive direction for them.

#### Chue Style Feng Shui can solve a wide variety of problems in people's lives.




### "5 YELLOW" Star of illness in the North West in 2023 Composed by Master Laurent Paillard (ICD)

In Feng Shui we use a technique related to the energies that move annually, it is called "Chee Ba flying stars".

The flying stars combine to bring us good or bad energies related to learning, love relationships, but also bad combinations related to disputes, illness and other bad energies.

Below you have the table with the combinations of the numbers for 2023.



This year 2023 we have an energy of illness in the North West direction, the orientation which represents the male leader, the father, the leader of a company, of a house.

We will also pay attention to this orientation in a bedroom, an office, a living room. This energy is set in motion with the number 5, which is called the "yellow 5".

When the 5 is in the Center of the Lo Shu square, it is in its place and does not really pose a problem, but when it moves, it brings with it this energy of illness.

This is an orientation which will impact a man in his decisions and his state of health in 2023. To illustrate, here is an explanation of this energy.

A 72-year-old man who lives in a house, where the front door is in the northwest decides to help nurses with a practical exercise in their profession.

He simulates a fall in his living room, the nurses arrive with a yellow ambulance to carry out their exercise.

Everything goes well, the exercise is successful, the neighbours come to ask about the person's health as an ambulance is parked outside his front door.



What the person did not imagine was that this service to the community would bring in the energy of illness into the house.

The yellow ambulance, the nurses, everything related to illness. That energy would come in from the North West, the male leader's orientation.

The exercise took place on Thursday without any problems, but unfortunately on the Saturday morning my neighbour had an AIT. Of course we can't make an absolute link between the two actions, however he still brought this bad energy into the house.

His wife approached me to see how we could help him as they had already had results previously with other requests.

We put a protective talisman in place for the person who quickly regained his health. We put a protection over the door to repel the energy of the illness, a personal talisman for the person and we did their Chinese horoscope or BaZi to see if there was anything else to do.

By looking at the date of the AIT, his BaZi and the elements between them, we could see that there was an energy related to fire that attacks the head.

The head and mouth being represented by the metal element and as the fire was attacking this element, it resulted in a deformation of the mouth, speech problems and a clash in the head.

For 2023 we have this disease energy in the North West, but as the method of calculation so aptly mentions, the Flying Stars move every year and the problem moves, in 2024 the yellow 5 will be in the West and so on.

It may involve another family member, another part of the body and many other things, especially if we have a door in the relevant orientation.


What is important to understand is that we can protect ourselves from this energy, we can anticipate by not putting yellow color (5) in this direction, nor black (2) and to call upon the Feng Shui Consultants of the Chue Feng Shui Foundation who will be able to advise you, to offer you solutions.

甲person born in autumn. Timing is wrong. He was born 17 days after Lap Chow, pure 庚金 metal. In autumn especially 申month, 木wood has no energy and 木wood is totally dead. 庚 金can chop the 木wood and 申金 can crash to 木 wood root 寅but luckily there is 子水water to save this crash due to the combination 申子= ½ Water. Without 子water this is a useless horoscope, as 木 wood would be totally vanished.



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However this chart is quite good. Both stem and branch of the month are 金 metal. 金 Metal can produce 水water.  $\pm$  Earth in the year pillar can produce 金 metal. 金 Metal Produces 水 water, 水water nourishes 木wood. Thus, dead 木 wood becomes alive. 起死回生格 Back to life form. You cannot control strong 金 metal, you need to drain them by using 水 water, then 水water can nourish 木 wood.

This is a weak horoscope, therefore, using elements are  $\pi$  water and  $\pi$ wood. In this chart,  $\pi$  water is strong to nourish  $\pi$  wood. Avoid element is  $\oplus$  metal and  $\pm$  earth.

All five elements in this chart have their own 禄 gin luk/ root. 甲木 Wood has 干禄(Gin luk) in 寅 木wood hour pillar. 丙 火 fire has 干禄(Gin luk) in 已火 life house. Water 子 combines to 申 to make ½ water and 丙 火 fire also combines to 辛 金 metal to become 水 water. So combined 水 water also has 干禄(Gin luk). Thus all five elements are present in this chart and have their own 干禄 (Gin luk). All elements are also going into hour pillar. ± Earth produces  $\pounds$  metal,  $\pounds$  metal produces  $\land$  water,  $\land$  water nourishes 木wood, 木 wood produces  $\lor$  fire. All the elements support each other.

He will be better when he is older. Because 甲木 has 干禄 (Gin luk) in the hour pilar 寅木. 日祿歸時 (Gin luk guai shi), the older the better. Especially if the element in hour pillar is his using element.

He also has **heaven rare chi.** 甲戊庚 however it cannot help him much as this is not his using element, yet **things may happen quite quickly in his life**.

The chart has 丙火 fire to control 辛金 metal. 丙火 fire is strong as it sits over 寅木 wood. 水 Water is his 印 (Yan), 印 (Yan) is his support element 水, means mother supports him. Also 印 (yan) sits under his day stem at the partner position, partner also can give him support. But not his father, because father is his 才 pin choi.

From year pillar to hour pillar, 5 elements can go through in the chart.  $\pm$  Earth -金 metal -水 water-木 wood – 火fire. Each day stem they have 干禄 (gin luk), making them strong.
